NOTES FROM THE DEAN



Dear members and friends,

For many organists, the time period covered by this newsletter will be the busiest months of the year. Ash Wednesday is only a few days away. Before the next newsletter is published all of Lent and Easter will be in the books. For those involved in academia, these are crucial weeks of the second semester, as students prepare for finals and juries. Many in our Chapter have added preparations for our **Members' Recital on March 8th** to their schedule, and I am grateful for that.

Several years ago, when I was a young full-time church musician in a busy Catholic parish in Dallas, I lamented to an older colleague over lunch the pressure I felt preparing so much music for Lent, the Triduum, and Easter Sunday. I remember telling him that I felt a little like a juke box, mechanically pumping out the hits for Lent and Easter.

My colleague gave me some sage advice that I have tried to follow over the years. He advised that each time I went to church during this time I should try to arrive 15 minutes early and spend those 15 minutes just playing music that I love and enjoy. No pressure, no deadlines, no fretting over wrong notes. Just time spent enjoying the beauty of music you love and being reminded of why you love playing the organ. It's not always possible to find the extra time, but I encourage you during this season to find a way to re-kindle and recharge your love of music.

Best wishes for a meaningful Lent and Easter if you celebrate those seasons, and a beautiful spring to all.

ELECTION NOTES







AGO-HQ INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SYSTEM

The long-awaited change from the ONCARD system to the new iMIS program happened on October 15, 2024. It is now essential that every member has their date of birth in the system, or it will charge you the full \$120 renewal subscription. The new policy DOES NOT provide for any grace period of paying dues beyond the renewal date. So, if you have a renewal date of January 1st and do not make your payment by that date, your membership will be cancelled approximately two weeks later. This pattern of processing will occur every month at each renewal date during the year. The AGO accepts payments by both credit cards and personal check.

Members should have received instructions about the new login procedure. You will be required to have a valid email address, which will be verified during the first login procedure. If you're unsure, ask our Dean, [Jeremy Wirth](#)

Also, paid "Positions Vacant" or requests for volunteer musicians and singers can be advertised free of charge.
